

ReadingWise Zip

Zip's objective is to close the gap between reading age and chronological age in KS1.

Zip is the ReadingWise phonics programme. It uses adaptive learning via algorithms to understand how secure a pupil is in relation to a letter/ word-sound correspondence.

Key points

- ◆ The Zip Module is a collection of 1000s of bite-sized lessons.
- ◆ Everything is delivered online, via a web-browser.
- ◆ The programme is designed to be run in short bursts, as regularly as possible. We suggest 3-5 sessions every week. Each session is 5-10 minutes long.
- ◆ The programme is designed to be very simple to use. Activities are straightforward, encouraging independence and building self esteem. The programme gets more challenging at the individual's own pace.
- ◆ Pupils are in control of their own learning, it is self-paced and they are rewarded throughout. Pupils don't have to refer to others for help, evidence suggests this helps pupils become more independent learners which also builds self esteem.
- ◆ ReadingWise Zip is fun! Lessons are short, simple and achievable. Learners are rewarded regularly, with tokens and humorous animations.
